**Warm-up: You may use a whiteboard (Expo) marker to complete the work on your desk.**

A theater has 24 seats in each row. There are 382 people that want to attend the premiere of a movie. How many rows would the theater need to seat all of these people?

$$\begin{array}{r} 15 \text{ r } 22 \\ 24 \overline{) 382} \\ \underline{24} \phantom{0} \\ 142 \\ \underline{120} \\ 22 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 2 \cdot 24 \\ \times 5 \\ \hline 120 \end{array}$$

The theater would need 16 rows. If they only had 15, 22 people would be left standing.
